

DRAFT - County Regulations of Coiste Chill Dara 2026

1. Each club shall nominate a delegate to the Co. Committee yearly. His/her name shall appear on the club register as such. Such a delegate shall have power to appoint a proxy to attend meetings of the Co. Committee but not to County Convention.
2. The following fees shall be paid annually: Public Liability and Property Insurance Premium, Registration Fees (All of which are paid directly to Croke Park), Affiliation, Administration and League Fees, Hawkfield Payments, Club Draw entry payments and Scór contribution. Clubs who do not have payment plans agreed for all monies due by the 1st June as sanctioned and due to the County Board will not receive tickets for the next All Ireland in both codes.
3. Clubs that default or are not up to date with payments of fees (as per Regulation #2 and sanctioned by County Committee) may not be permitted to participate in their respective championships. Clubs that default and are not up to date with payments relating to the All-County Draw will lose home advantage at all adult level games including minor in the following year's League Competitions whilst also being subject to fines Rule 3.41(0) T.O.
4. A Club shall not send forward to Convention a motion that has not been discussed, voted on and approved by members of the Club or Executive. Minutes of the respective Club AGM or Executive meeting must accompany the submitted motion in accordance with Rule 3.12.T.O.
5. (a) Except in exceptional circumstances the Co. Committee shall meet on the first Tuesday of the following months; February, March, June, September and November at a venue to be decided by the Co. Committee. Five members shall form a quorum. The Co. Chairperson, Co. Vice-Chairperson or Co. Secretary must be present.

(b) A Special Meeting shall be called at the written request of the nominated County delegate of five clubs. The request must set out in detail the purpose of the meeting.

(c) The Co. Chairperson and/or Secretary are empowered to call a Special Meeting of the Co. Committee.
6. The Co. Secretary shall notify club secretaries at least four days before a Co. Committee meeting. It shall be the club's responsibility to inform the club delegate. Two days' notice shall be sufficient for a Special Meeting as per Bye-Law 5(b & c).
7. Clubs are responsible for the safe upkeep of trophies in their custody and will be liable for any repairs or replacements. All trophies must be returned to the County Offices in Manguard Plus, Hawkfield on or before the below deadlines - Failure to comply shall entail a fine of €200.
 - Pre-Season & Minor League Trophies to be returned on or before the March County Board Meeting.
 - All other Trophies to be returned on or before the June County Board Meeting.
8. Permission to live stream Adult Kildare CCC fixtures will only be granted should it meet the below criteria:
 - The fixture is deemed to be a sold-out event.
 - The fixture is not streamed by Kildare GAA.

- 9.** Videos of games subject to CCC permission: Full & unedited copy of match video to be submitted to CCC within 48 hours of request from the Committee. Failure to comply with this will result in a minimum €200 fine.
- 10.** Match Day regulations will be issued by the CCC before the first round of the championship and breaches of these regulations will result in sanction as set out in said match day regulations.

- 11.** Clubs shall submit their Officer contact details, including their nominated delegate to the County Committee, to the County Secretary before the first Monday of March. Clubs Officer list to also include: Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, PRO, Designated Liaison Person, Children's Officer, Health & Wellbeing Officer, Development Officer, Coaching Officer and Irish Officer.
