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Réamhrá.

‘Tá an Ghaeilge ag croílár Chumann Luthchleas Gael’, de réir shuíomh idirlíon na heagraíochta agus is cinnte go bhfuil sé sin le feiceáil d’einne a thugann fiú srachhéacahint ar na gníomhaíochtaí ar fad a bhíonn idir láimhe ann.

I gContae Chill Dara, úsáideann go leor clubanna an leagan Gaeilge dá nainmneacha, tá Oifigigh Gaeilge ceaptha ag a lán acu agus go dtí le déanaí bhíodh na fógraí ag Páirc Naomh Connladh dátheangach don chuid is mó. Is i 2019 a thosaigh Fondúireacht Sheosaimh Mhic Dhonncha ag obair sa chondae, agus ó shin i leith tá 12 chlub i gCill Dara cláraithe agus tá €5,590 bronnta ar na clubanna sin chun cabhrú leo an Ghaeilge a chur chun cinn.

I suirbhé (cuir isteach an méid a d’fhreagair) a chuir na clubanna ar a mbaill féin i 2020 dúirt 73% de na daoine a d’fhreagair gur mhaith leo go mbeadh ‘stádas níos airde ag an nGaeilge i saol oifigiúil an chlub’

Ag deireadh na bliana 2021 beidh 6 chlub tar éis aitheantas a bhaint amach de bharr a gcuid oibre ar son na Gaeilge sa bhFondúireacht, trí bhoinn bheith bronnta orthu I bpáirc an Chrócaigh.

Níl anseo ach an túis, is cinnte go bhfuil a lán clubanna agus baill eile a bhfuil suim acu bheith páirteach ach nár éirigh leo go fóill.

Gan amhras, aithnítear go bhfuil teanga na Gaeilge láidir i gCill Dara, le 8 nGaelscoil agus 2 Gaelcholáiste ag feidhmiú laistigh de theorainneacha an chontae.

Strategic Plan for the Irish Language in the Gaelic Athletic Association in Kildare

Introduction.

‘The Irish language is at the heart of the Gaelic Athletic Association’, according to the organisation’s website and this is certainly visible to anyone who even takes a look at all the activities on offer.

In County Kildare, many clubs use the Irish version of their names, many have appointed Irish Language Officers and until recently the advertisements at Páirc Naomh Connladh were largely bilingual. The Seosaimh Mhic Dhonncha Foundation began working in the county in 2019, and since then 12 clubs in Kildare have been registered and € 5,590 has been awarded to these clubs to help them promote the Irish language.

In a survey (insert response) conducted by the clubs on their members in 2020, 73% of respondents stated that they would like ‘Irish to have a higher status in the official life of the club’

At the end of 2021, 6 clubs in Kildare will have been recognized for their work on behalf of the Irish language in the Foundation, by being awarded medals in Croke Park.

This is just the beginning, there are certainly many clubs and other members who are interested in getting involved but have not yet succeeded.

Undoubtedly, it is recognized that the Irish language is strong in Kildare, with 8 Gaelscoils and 2 Gaelcholáiste operating within the county boundaries.

Moltaí

Ag éirí as an méid thusas tá na moltaí seo a leanas á dhéanamh ag Oifigeach na Gaeilge, Bord an Chondae, mar bhunús agus ‘sé an dóchas ná go mbeidh a bhformhór curtha i gcrích roimh dheireadh na bliana 2026 agus go mbeidh sé tóghtha san áireamh i bPlean Stráitéiseach an Chumainn don chondae.

Proposals

Arising from the above, the Irish Language Officer, Bord an Chondae, is making the following recommendations as a basis and it is hoped that most of them will be completed by the end of 2026 and will be taken into account. in the Society's Strategic Plan for the county.

Leanfar ar aghaidh leis an dea-obair atá ar siúl leis na comórtais Gaeilge , Amhránaíochta, Scéalaíochta, Bailéid, Léiriú Státse agus Aithriseoireachta ag Scór agus ag Scór na nÓg.	<i>The good work going on with the Irish, Singing, Storytelling, Ballads, Stage Performance and Recitation competitions at Scór and Scór na nÓg will continue.</i>
Úsáidfear ‘Cill Dara’ amháin feasta ar gheansaithe, stáisiúnéireacht 7rl.	<i>Only ‘Cill Dara’ will now be used on jerseys, stationery etc.</i>
Iarrfar ar gach club sa chondae Oifigeach Gaeilge/ Cultúr a cheapadh agus ainmneofar na ceapacháin sin ar shuíomh idirlíon an Bhoird.	<i>All clubs in the county will be asked to appoint an Irish Language / Culture Officer and these appointments will be named on the Board's website.</i>
Beidh sé mar sprioc go mbeidh ar a laghad leath de na clubanna sa chondae cláraithe le Fondúireacht Sheosaimh Mhic Dhonncha roimh dheireadh 2026	<i>It will be a goal to have at least half of the clubs in the county registered with the Joe McDonagh Foundation by the end of 2026</i>
Beidh sé mar sprioc go mbeidh ar a laghad 15 dheontas do scoláireachtaí Gaeltachta á gcur ar fail go bliantúil ag an mBord roimh dheireadh 2026	<i>It will be a goal of the Board to provide at least 15 grants for Gaeltacht scholarships annually by the end of 2026.</i>
Beidh sé ina pholasáí cinnte ag an mBord aitheantas a thabhairt do chumas labhartha agus scríobh sa Ghaeilge nuair atá ceapachán á ndéanamh.	<i>It will be a firm policy of the Board to recognize the ability to speak and write in Irish when making appointments.</i>
Cuirfear túis le gach fógra le focal nó dhó i nGaeilge.	<i>Each announcement will begin with a word or two in Irish.</i>

Déanfar téarmaí Gaeilge a mhíniú sa chlár.	<i>Irish terms will be explained in the programme.</i>
Beidh clár na scór as Gaeilge amháin i 'bPáirceanna an Chondae' úsáidfear an focal 'Cuairteoir' in ionad 'Visitors'i bpáirceanna na gclubanna.	<i>The scoreboard will be in Irish in County Grounds throughout the county and the word 'Cuairteoir' will be used instead of 'Visitors'in club pitches.</i>
Beidh idir Ghaeilge agus Béarla ar thicéid, ar phaimfléid agus ar fhoilseacháin an Bhoird.	<i>Tickets, pamphlets and Board publications will be in both Irish and English.</i>
Tógfaidh an Bord pleanáil don Ghaeilge san áireamh agus an Plean Stráitéiseach don Chondae á dhréachtadh.	<i>The Board will take planning for the Irish language into account when drafting the Strategic Plan for the County.</i>

Beidh Tráth na gCeist dátheangach ag Scór.(Athrú sna rialacha ag teastáil)	<i>Score will have a bilingual Quiz.(A rule change may be necessary)</i>
Beidh cinnteidil na miontuairisci as Gaeilge sa chumainn i gcoitinne.	<i>The headings of the minutes will be in Irish in general.</i>
Eagrófar Cúlcamp amháin as Gaeilge.	<i>One Cúlcamp will be held in Irish.</i>
Beidh Gaeilge ag hoiliúnóirí a théann isteach sna scoileanna thar cheann an CLG agus tabharfar treoir dóibh faoin méid Gaeilge a bheidh á usáid acu.	<i>Coaches who enter the schools on behalf of the GAA will speak Irish and will be given guidance on how much Irish they will be using.</i>
Beidh Foirmeacha larratais dátheangach i gcónaí (ach amháin nuair atá iarratas á dhéanamh ar dheontas chun freastal ar chúrsa Gaeltachta- beidh seo as Gaeilge amháin) agus glacfar le hiarratais as Gaeilge.	<i>Application Forms will always be bilingual (except in the case of applications for grants for Gaeltacht courses – these will be in Irish only)and applications will be accepted in Irish.</i>
Eagrófar comórtais peile, iománaíochta agus camógaíochta do na Gaelscoileanna sa chondae.	<i>Football, hurling and camogie competitions will be organized for the Gaelscoileanna in the county.</i>
Tabharfar cead do na clubanna atá cláraithe leis an bhFondúireacht comórtas dá gcuid féin a eagrú go bliantúil.	<i>Clubs registered with the Foundation will be allowed to organize their own competition on an annual basis.</i>
Cuirfear 'G' in aice le hainmneacha réiteoirí atá sásta Gaeilge a labhairt.	<i>'G' will be placed next to the names of referees who are willing to speak Irish.</i>
Beidh 'Ambasadóirí na Gaeilge' ceaptha thar cheann foirne sinsearacha sa Pheil, san iománaíocht agus sa Chamógaíocht.	<i>'Irish Language Ambassadors' will be appointed on behalf of senior teams in Football, Hurling and Camogie.</i>
